

PEAC Accreditation Committee Entry-to-Practice Physiotherapist Member Call for Applications

October 16, 2023

Physiotherapy Education Accreditation Canada's (*PEAC*) is responsible for the accreditation of entry-to-practice physiotherapy education programs in Canada.

We are pleased to announce a call for applications to be considered for PEAC's Accreditation Committee. PEAC is looking to recruit an Entry-to-Practice Physiotherapist Member to begin in February 2024. The Entry-to-Practice Physiotherapist Member is one who is within three years of graduation at the time of appointment.

The committee consists of 9 to 12 committee members who meet once a year in person and usually three times per year virtually. The committee's purpose and responsibilities are described in the Terms of Reference (*TOR-08: Accreditation Committee*). Information about eligibility is found in *GUIDE-01*.

The candidates must be available to attend a two-day meeting once a year, attend shorter virtual meetings approximately three times per year, and commit to completing the necessary additional work between meetings. Sometimes this work is substantial. The candidates should be interested in gaining experience in program accreditation and in learning about accreditation standards and the evaluation of programs against those standards. Each physiotherapy program in Canada completes the full accreditation process at least once every six years.

All expenses to attend meetings are covered (flight, meals, hotel, etc.) but PEAC is unable to compensate members for their time.

The term of office for the Entry-to-Practice Physiotherapist member is three years and is not renewable. The successful candidate will be appointed to the committee at the January 2024 meeting of the Board of Directors and attend their first Accreditation Committee meeting in April 2024. Their three-year term would end at the January 2027 meeting.

To reflect the diversity of our stakeholders and profession, we encourage those with visible minorities, Indigenous Peoples, persons of diverse sexual orientation, gender

identity or expression (LGBTQ2S+) and others from under-represented groups to put their names forward.

Please note that while the work of the committee is conducted primarily in English, preference will be given to applicants with ability in French so as to assist in the work to review documentation related to the accreditation process for Francophone programs. - a curriculum vitae, and
- a statement summarizing interest in the position
